

General Food Vendor Agreement 2022

- Festival is rain or shine.
- Food Vendors must meet state-issued requirements and have any and all required permits and certificates of insurance clearly posted on the day-of.
- Food Vendor Temporary Application if you do not have a Commercial Caterer mobile or Fair Stand annual license.

- Food Vendor booth fee is \$75 and is due by May 20, 2022. No refunds will be given after June 10TH.
 - Make Checks Payable to Revitalizing Waterbury and Mail Application to:
 - WATERBURY ARTS FEST, C/O REVITALIZING WATERBURY, PO BOX 473, WATERBURY, VT 05676
- The WAF relies on your commitment to vend at our festival. If you must cancel, we need
 notice by May 20, 2022. Failure to notify us by this time will jeopardize our ability to fill
 your spot and serve our customers. This is considered breach of contract and may
 involve a fine.
- The WAF needs to make sure all food vendors have equal opportunity to serve our customers and that no two vendors are serving the same foods. Therefore, we require advanced notice of the planned menu as well as notice for any significant menu changes from what you list on your Agreement Form. This notice is also due by May 20, 2022
- Vendors are responsible for collecting any necessary Vermont sales tax from buyers. If you do not have a tax account, you can download an application from the Vermont Department of Taxes website (there is no charge for a tax account.):

- Electrical power is NOT available.
- Water access is very limited but available upon request.
- Bathroom facilities are available during the show and the locations will be clearly posted.
